We joined a community cycle for protected bike lanes and launched petitions to upgrade cycling facilities when roads are resurfaced in Morningside and Rochedale. Around the suburbs, we have updates from Norman Park, Indooroopilly, Rocklea, and Brisbane Airport. We kicked off our state election campaign this week with a ride around the Bulimba electorate with LNP candidate Anthony Bishop. you the latest news from Nudgee, Banyo, West End, Morningside, Murarrie, Lytton, Wynnum and Brisbane Airport. All cycleways lead to better health! Bikeways keep popping up, but not in Brisbane. Around the suburbs, we visit Indooroopilly, Toombul, Cannon Hill, Murarrie, Dutton Park, Oxley, and Coorparoo. No cycleways have popped up in Brisbane yet. Around the suburbs we visited Salisbury, Rocklea, Oxley, and Coorparoo. Bicycle signage includes several subcategories. These include wayfinding and route signage, regulatory signage, and warning signage. Some bicycle specific signage exists to provide motorized traffic with information and instruction. These markings must take into consideration the use of particular colors, materials, and designs, as well as the legibility of these elements for motorists and pedestrians. Markings may be used to augment a particular lane, intersection, or signal treatment. In all cases, markings must strive for a high level of visibility, instant identification, and take into account both motorist and bicyclist movements in relation to the marking placement.
